


## Protection and Hygiene Concept for Visitors to the Lexichaos Exhibition

This concept is to be read as an addition to the general hygiene concept in consideration of the pandemic SARS-COV-2 for the Pierre Boulez Saal of 07/09/2020, as well as its adaptations and changes.

1. In principle, the current hygiene rules are to be observed (see appendix and notices)
2. A minimum distance of 1.5 meters between persons must be ensured.
3. A maximum of 10 visitors per hour are allowed into the areas of the building open to visitors. The low number of visitors per hour, as well as the distance rules observed, are intended to prevent crowding.
4. To reduce contacts, visitors must book an admission ticket in advance with an assigned time slot. When tickets are booked, required contact information is collected to allow contact tracing, if necessary. This data will be retained and deleted in accordance with policy.
5. There has been a switch to digital ticketing to prevent queuing. Only in exceptional cases will the box office at the back of the foyer be used.
6. A checkroom will be opened next to the box office.
7. Visitors are required to wear mouth-nose protection (FFP2/KN95, surgical mask) at all times while in the Pierre Boulez Saal. Appropriate mouth-nose protection will be provided to visitors upon entry to the building, if applicable. Mouth-to-nose covering that does not meet the standards of mouth-to-nose protection is not permitted. This does not apply to persons with health restrictions such as respiratory diseases upon presentation of an appropriate medical certificate.
8. Hand disinfectant dispensers with limited virucidal disinfectant are available throughout the building, including areas open to visitors. Frequently used surfaces, such as door handles, handrails on stairs, tables, etc., are disinfected several times a day by cleaning staff.
9. Rooms with windows are ventilated at regular intervals. Rooms without windows are supplied by a ventilation system, including the Saal: Observations of the air flows have shown that there is no risk to visitors from virus-laden aerosols, while maintaining defined distances, as the air is discharged directly upwards. The fresh air flow rate of the room air technology is set as high as possible.
10. Food and beverages will not be served.
11. During the opening hours of the exhibition, there will be a separation of the public and students and academy employees via assigned walkways in the building as well as the maintenance of distances in order to prevent a possible infection event.
12. The visitors' toilets are located in the basement. The stairs from the foyer to the UG may be used in either direction, provided that visitors move directly in one direction along the handrail. (Men's WC maximum 2 persons from one household, otherwise 1 person, in the entire area, in the area of the washbasins a 1 hand-free disinfectant dispenser; Women's WC maximum 2 persons from one household, otherwise 1 person, in the entire area, 2 hand-free disinfectant dispensers). Notices are posted on the doors in each case that only 2 people are allowed in the toilet area and that attention must be paid to minimum distances. This is additionally checked by an employee.
13. The elevator may only be used by one person at a time, unless more than one person belongs to the same household. Handicapped persons may use the elevator with an accompanying person.


