**INTERMISSION with more than 500,000 views from 136 countries**  
More concerts and lectures in the upcoming weeks

The Pierre Boulez Saal's digital concert series INTERMISSION has so far reached over 500,000 viewers from 136 countries. In the coming weeks, the successful programme continues with partly unreleased video recordings: On April 29, the Belcea Quartet will perform works by Mozart, Shostakovich and Brahms together with violist Antoine Tamestit. On May 1, Sir András Schiff will explore the six piano partitas of Johann Sebastian Bach in lecture and concert. Daniel Barenboim is featured with his Schubert piano sonata cycle from 2017.

For the first time, students of the Barenboim-Said Akademie are also part of the INTERMISSION programme: In a recording from 2018, they present works by Felix Mendelssohn Bartholdy and Anton Webern. Since the opening of the Pierre Boulez Saal, the series of Academy Concerts has been an integral part of its musical programme and prepares young musicians for their entry into international music scene.
